- Could have also discussed volunteer/ staff management further – a common issue for many non-profits.
- Several sessions were poor; discussion circles were poor.
- More dialogue with guest speakers rather than each other; narrow non-profit attendance.
- I think Day One was a bit below the audience and Day One Leadership Circle Questions were a bit ambiguous and not really well structured.
- No focus on indigenous issues within Australia – an 'Aid' focus in most of the examples.
- Intensity of interest not maintained – too many highs/ lows.
- While I found much of it useful it was too much oriented towards large charitable organisations.
- Did not receive handouts to write comments of the presenters – having to buy CD or DVD is an additional unexpected cost of attending the Summit.
